A message from our leadership...

our history that every child from 3rd through 9th grades attended a month-long camp session. Why would we want to work so hard to make that possible? Two short stories answer the question.

Every 3rd and 4th grade boy in the Archery Club mastered the skills involved to be able to hit the bullseye. Many went on to achieve the rank of "Eagle Eye" by hitting the bullseye three times in one activity period. The opportunity to **achieve mastery** is part of the answer – mastery of all the skills involved, including patience, persistence, and practice to achieve a goal.

On the very last day of camp, six girls, also in 3rd and 4th grade, tried without success to climb some of the hardest elements on our five-story Tango Tower. They had already mastered many of the other, less-challenging climbs. After almost two hours of attempts, I heard them tell one another: "That's okay," "We really tried hard," "Next year we'll be bigger and stronger," and "We can try again." In their words of encouragement and support for one another, I witnessed these girls **demonstrate persistence, determination, grit, optimism, and hope.**

Those characteristics are some of the hallmarks of successful adults. In the opportunities that come as a result of both long-term experiences and relationships, our kids learn the practices and skills that will lead them into their bright futures. We could not do this work without your sustaining support, and I cannot thank you enough.

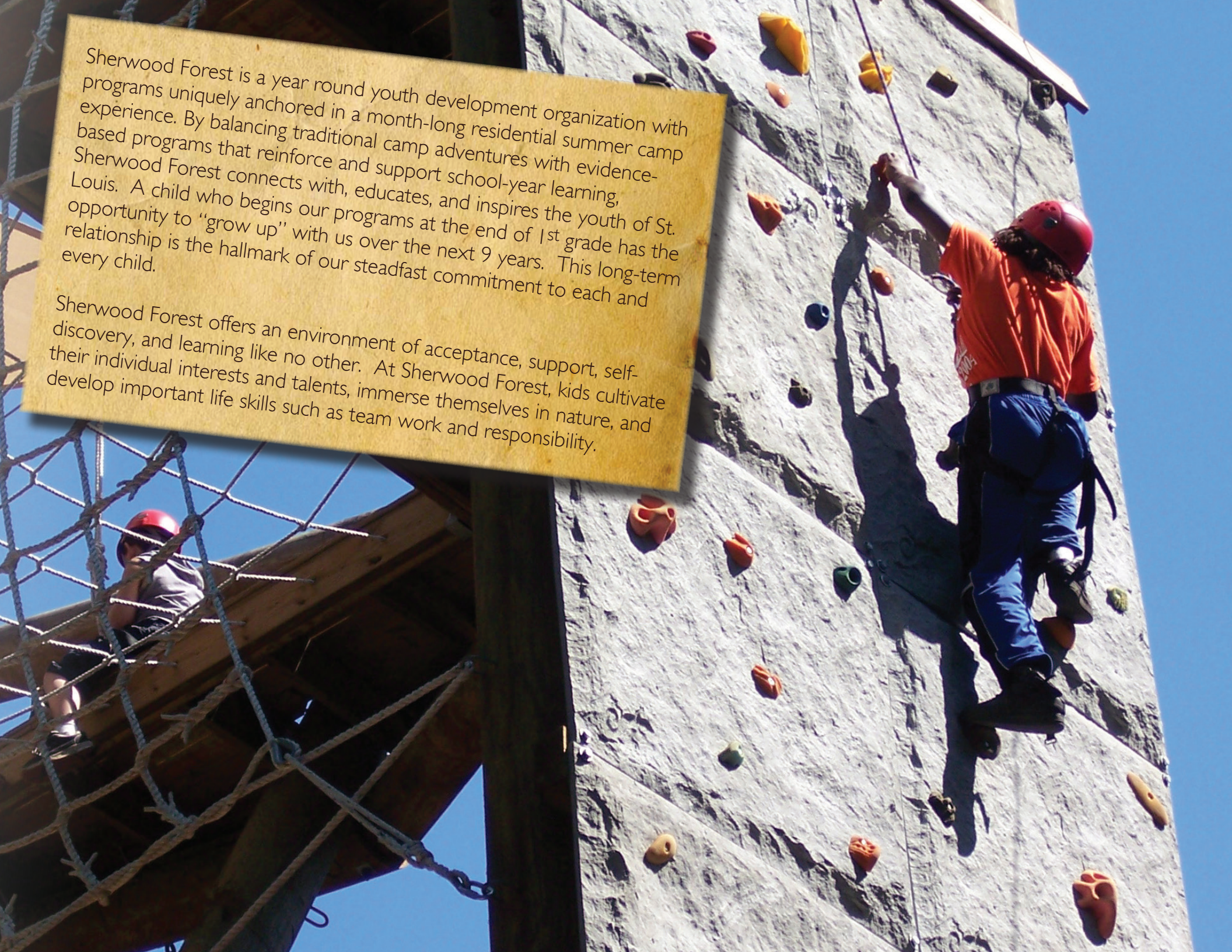

Each summer, the arts come alive at Sherwood Forest thanks to the continued generosity of the Arthur and Helen Baer Charitable Foundation! This St. Louis-based organization provides funding to a variety of area non-profits, and its strong focus on the arts and education makes it a natural fit for Sherwood Forest. Our arts offerings have expanded significantly over the last few summers thanks to the Foundation's vision and significant support.

At Sherwood Forest, the Baer Foundation Creative and Performing Arts Program emphasizes intellectual exploration, team-building, creativity, and hands-on skill-building. Campers experience challenging and engaging opportunities to learn and grow as they live alongside practicing artists, interacting with them each day in a supportive and positive environment.



Over the course of the 2013 summer, every single camper at Sherwood Forest participated in at least one arts activity. These ranged from traditional projects like jewelry-making and pottery, to innovative offerings such as digital radio production, pantomime, shadow puppetry, and superhero design! Campers demonstrate increasing interest in these activities each summer, so the ongoing support from the Baer Foundation is especially welcome.

Creating an environment where children have fun is one part of our goal, but we also believe that Sherwood Forest is a perfect place for kids to broaden their horizons and learn new things. Through activities in the arts, campers see their skills improve each day and experience a true sense of accomplishment.



Where Are They Now?

Sherwood Forest's innovative Leadership Training Program was founded in 1942, and over the last seven decades, program graduates have gone on to pursue a variety of careers: professors, psychologists, police officers, social workers, lawyers, healthcare professionals, journalists, and artists among many others. Each success story is unique, but they all have a common thread: Sherwood Forest has changed them for the better, and the skills they developed through the Leadership Training Program, such as responsibility, persistence, self-confidence, problem-solving, and teamwork, continue to shape their lives. Rose Holmes

- 1986 Leadership Graduate -



"It probably seems unlikely that sitting in a downtown courtroom would remind anyone of summer camp. However, last August as I sat through the trial of an Atlanta educator charged with various criminal acts, I was really trying to understand why any adult would jeopardize or rather sacrifice a student's learning ability for personal financial gain.

My thoughts also took me to a childhood place that I cherish so dearly. A place where wooded bunk beds embrace campers as they fall asleep to the night sounds of a whippoorwill. After all, it's been a long day of hiking to the mud cave or conquering a ropes course designed to build a cabin group's cohesiveness.

Quite often I long for those days.

In a career where I have to ask politicians about the lack of resources for the poor and the response is typically it's the other political party's fight, I have to resist the urge of saying, 'Don't you know the three principles of Sherwood Forest Camp, friendship, cooperation and learning, would really come in handy during the legislative session?' I want to tell them that kids from low-income communities need help to experience places like Sherwood Forest Camp. People that can enrich the lives of our nation's youth need to know that a 12-year-old little African American girl can grow up to be an award-winning journalist who's traveled to faraway places.

Outside of my family, the second most important place that's had a significant influence in my life is Sherwood Forest. What I recall most are experiences beyond remembering the trail to Lee Mountain or how to properly pack a backpack (by the way, I still do). It's the caring nature of the staff coupled with the daily camp activities, I still hold close to my heart. To this day, I still have a close friendship with my camp director, my first village director, fellow campers, and those that I graduated with in the leadership program.

Now in my professional career, when I speak to students, moderate forums or even address corporate types, I'll relay a Sherwood Forest Camp story. I'm proud to tell them the impact it had on my life, from learning to respect the environment and above all, learning to respect others."

"I started going to Sherwood when I was 11 years old and graduated from the leadership program at age 16. What I learned at camp has taken me to Colorado, introduced me to my wife, introduced my brother to his wife, and allowed me to see others' and my actions in a larger context.

Through my experiences at Sherwood, I have made friends from around the world and learned about cultures that I may never have had the opportunity to experience. Sherwood taught me to accept and to learn from others' differences as opposed to seeing them as a barrier. This lesson and many more have led me to the career that I am currently enjoying: working with troubled teens for the Division of Youth Services.

The myriad of different ideas on religion, diet, music, and dance have allowed me to dream bigger than I might have before. The skills and love for the outdoors that I gained at Sherwood have guided my life through my choices of employment, companionship, and recreation.

Perhaps the biggest lesson that I learned at Sherwood was a sense of responsibility for my community and a willingness to help. Mary has always been an inspiration and a guide, let alone a great job reference. I thank her for all of the wisdom that she has tried to imbue, and I thank Sherwood for a million other wonders."

"Sherwood Forest will always have a special place in my heart. It is part of the foundation that makes me the leader I am today. Currently, I am in the U.S. Marine Corps working in electronics maintenance. I just recently returned from a two-year duty station in Okinawa, Japan. I am now in Cherry Point, North Carolina. After only two months of being here, I have already be named 'NCO (non-commissioned officer) of the Quarter' in recognition of my leadership. I would like to thank Sherwood Forest and all of its supporters for being a part of who I am today.

While in North Carolina, I surely will not be wasting any time. I am currently working on obtaining a Bachelor's degree in Electronics Systems Technology. Currently, I am deciding whether to leave the Marine Corps to pursue a career in electronics, or to stay and become an officer. Either route I take, I will surely do my best at it!"

College visits are an important component of our Leadership Training Program, and over the last two years alone, our campers have traveled to the University of Louisville, Purdue University, the University of Notre Dame, Belmont University, Tennessee State University, University of Kentucky, and Ohio State University.

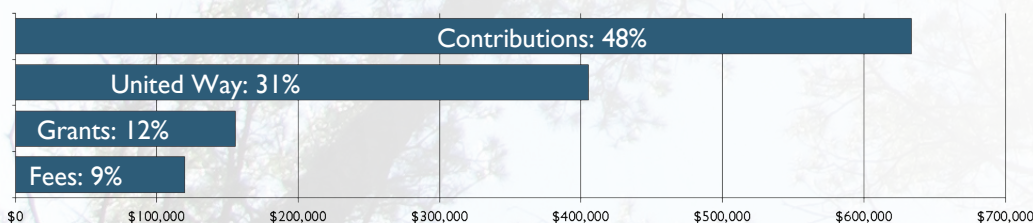

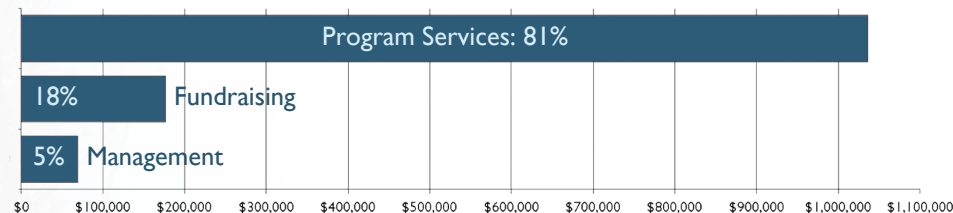
