



Sherwood Forest Foundation Gift Acceptance Policy

Approved – August 7, 2018

About Sherwood Forest Foundation and the Purpose of These Policies

Sherwood Forest Foundation (the “Foundation:”) is a tax-exempt nonprofit corporation under section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code (EIN# 83-1345680). It is also a Supporting Organization of Sherwood Forest Camp, Inc. (EIN# 43-0653401) under section 509(a)3 of the Internal Revenue Code. The Foundation is registered in good standing with the Secretary of State of the State of Missouri. The purpose of the Foundation is to support Sherwood Forest Camp’s fundraising and financing activities related to capital campaigns and capital improvements.

The purpose of these policies is to govern the acceptance of gifts made to the Foundation for the benefit of any of its activities, funds, or programs. These policies are intended to assist the Foundation Board of Directors and the staff of Sherwood Forest Camp, Inc. with gift acceptance decisions. These policies can also be used by a donor and/or professional advisor in making charitable gift decisions.

Types of gifts

It is the policy of the Foundation to direct donors wishing to support the activities, funds, or programs of the Foundation to do so by making a gift to Sherwood Forest Camp, Inc. The gift will then be transferred from Sherwood Forest Camp, Inc. to the Foundation. The Foundation is only able to accept gifts of cash, check or wire transfer.

The Foundation may on rare occasions accept cash gifts from a donor. The gift must be made by cash, check, or wire transfer. Checks shall be made payable to Sherwood Forest Foundation.

Restrictions on gifts

Gifts made to Sherwood Forest Camp, Inc. are subject to its Gift Acceptance Policy. When Sherwood Forest Camp, Inc. accepts a gift with restrictions from a donor that is subsequently transferred to the Foundation, it is the policy of the Foundation to also honor those restrictions.
